SAFETY TIPS AND FALL CLEAN UP

LEAVES LEAVES LEAVES... Leaves are now falling from the trees and landing on the roads and in drainage areas. This not only makes for slippery roads, but also blocks drains from allowing the runoff of water to flow and not cause flooding on the roadway. If you are a homeowner with such a drainage ditch/area, please take a few minutes to check the status and correct any blockage.

Don't let fallen leaves get the best of you, BUT DO NOT blow them into the roadway. Rake them up, shred them and use them as mulch for young trees, shrubs, and flower beds. You might even be able to skip the raking part if you use a lawn mower to mulch the leaves in your yard.

This is the perfect time to clear leaves and other debris from rain gutters. Check for proper drainage, clear out any blockages with a small garden trowel, and rinse with a hose.
