As many of our neighbors may have noticed, the dock at Lake George was starting to fall into disrepair as some of the stringers were rotting. Under the recent planning and direction of Steve Silva and Brian Swift of the lake committee, the walkway to the dock was carefully disassembled. New lumber was used to build new stringers and a new gangway to the floating dock, and the chains which had held the dock to anchors under water were replaced. The dock is once again open to the community thanks to the expeditious work of Brian and Steve, with special thanks to helpers Skip Lepone and John Novak.
